**THE USE OF INTERACTIONAL STRATEGIES AS SEEN IN
DEADPOOL & WOLVERINE THE MOVIE (2024)**

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Abstract

This thesis examines communication strategies employed in the movie “Deadpool & Wolverine” focusing on the ways interactional strategies support character dynamics and narrative progression. The study examines how characters use various strategies to manage misunderstandings, negotiate meaning, and maintain effective interaction. A qualitative descriptive method was applied, and 50 data points were analysed from the film’s dialogue. The findings reveal four types of interactional strategies: Expressing non-understanding (1), Responses (25), Appeals for Help (17), and Meaning Negotiation Strategies (7). In addition, the study identifies three main functions of communication strategies: Psycholinguistic Perspective (5), Interactional Perspective (40), and Maintenance Perspective (5). The results show that Deadpool frequently uses humour and self-awareness to ease tension, while Wolverine relies on concise and serious responses to maintain clarity. These strategies illustrate that communication functions as a cooperative process, allowing characters to adapt challenges, clarify meaning, and sustain interaction. By highlighting the role of communication strategies in building relationships and advancing the story, this thesis contributes to broader discussions in film studies and communication

CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of The Research

A movie is a strong component for expressing messages, emotions, and various cultural stories. Movies and communication have an interesting bond, so closely related and connected. The movie can generate significant feelings from many characters through dialogue, plot, and communication. Communication is based on the characters with each other, and also on the plot of this movie. Furthermore, a movie uses different types of communication-based and cultural aspects that can be included in communication strategies to ensure the context of the interaction is understood. Therefore, this makes studying communication more interesting than ever, especially when looking at movies that play with different ways of talking to their audience.

In regard to communication strategies, the movie *Deadpool & Wolverine* (2024) offers a perfect opportunity to study these communication strategies in action. The movie brings together two characters with completely different communication styles: Deadpool, who regularly breaks the fourth wall by talking directly to the movie audience and making jokes about being in a movie, and Wolverine, who communicates in a more traditional, serious manner. This contrast creates an ideal situation for studying how different communication styles can work together within the same story. In addition, the movie's position within the Marvel Cinematic Universe makes it particularly valuable for studying communication. As characters move between different situations and interact with various other characters, they must constantly adjust their communication styles.

Deadpool's ability to acknowledge his communication skill he is in a movie adds another layer to this analysis, as he can communicate with both other characters and the audience simultaneously. This reflects modern communication trends, where people often engage in multiple conversations across different platforms at the same time. Moreover, the movie combines different types of storytelling – action, comedy, and superhero genres – each requiring its own way of communicating. This mixture creates situations where characters must quickly switch between different communication strategies, from making jokes to having serious conversations. Studying these switches helps the writer understand how people adapt their communication style based on their situation, much like how we might change how we talk when moving between different social groups or settings. Therefore, by understanding the message in their interaction, there will be a function of their communication. In communication, the characters can improve their ability to understand their conversation, build on the communication, and accurately convey their intended meaning.

Therefore, by examining the elements of communication strategy contained in the movie, this study aims to highlight the significant importance of communication strategy as an aspect of life and the function of communication itself. Through this research, the writer's primary interest is to explore the types of communication strategies and functions represented through the movie, as can be reached to understand the importance of communication strategies as an aspect of our lives.

1.2 Research Questions

Based on the research background, the research questions are:

1. What are the types of interactional strategies used by the main characters in *Deadpool & Wolverine the Movie*?
2. What are the functions of the communication strategies implied by the main characters in *Deadpool & Wolverine the Movie*?

1.3 Purpose of the Research

This research aims to provide an understanding of the importance of communication strategies in the movie *Deadpool & Wolverine*. Therefore, the research aims are:

1. To discover the types of interactional strategies in *Deadpool & Wolverine* (2024).
